Affidavit

- 1. This form of affidavit may be used in any proceeding, save and except where another form of affidavit is applicable under the:
 - a. Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 1) Rules 2021;
 - b. Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 2) (Family Law) Rules 2021 (Family Law Rules);
 - c. Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 2) (Bankruptcy) Rules 2021;
 - d. Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia (Division 2) (General Federal Law) Rules 2021 (General Federal Law Rules).
- 2. Each paragraph in this affidavit must be numbered.
- 3. This affidavit must be sworn or affirmed before a person authorised by law to witness the swearing of affidavits; for example, a lawyer, notary public or Justice of the Peace.
- 4. Each page must be signed by the deponent (the person making the affidavit).
- 5. Any alteration in the affidavit must be initialled by the deponent and the witness.

- 9. If the facts in the affidavit are supported by a document, a copy of the document must be attached to this affidavit. This document is then referred to as an 'annexure'. If there is more than one annexure refer to each by a number or letter; for example 'Annexure 1' or 'Annexure A'. The annexure should also have page numbers. If there is more than one annexure, the page numbers must run consecutively until the last page of the last annexure. A document annexed or exhibited to an affidavit must be served with the affidavit. See Rule 8.15(4) of the Family Law Rules.
- 10. Each annexure must include a statement signed by the witness identifying the annexure as the document referred to in this affidavit. The wording of the statement is as follows:

- 12. If the deponent does not have an adequate command of English, a translator must read or give in writing a translation of the affidavit and oath/affirmation in a language which is understood, and must certify in the signing clause that he or she has done so. Use the alternative jurat for the swearing/affirming of the affidavit and the translator's certificate in Part F. See Rule 8.17 of the Family Law Rules.
- 13. Once complete, you need to file the affidavit and any annexures with the Court. It must be filed electronically on the Commonwealth Courts Portal (<u>www.comcourts.gov.au</u>) unless it is not reasonably practicable to do so. You will need to serve a copy on the other party or parties and keep a copy for your records.

- 9. Jane and Johnny continued to reside in the family home.
- 10. Following our separation, I commenced spending time with Johnny every second weekend.
- 11. I am currently in receipt of a Centrelink disability pension.
- 12. Until recently, Jane was employed full-time as a business manager at AMP and was earning approximately \$150,000 per year.

Contact with Jane Post-Separation

- On 2 January 20XX, I collected Johnny from McDonalds Parramatta and brought him back to my parents place.
- 14. On 13 January 20XX, Jane was supposed to pick up Johnny from my parents place but never arrived.
- 15. I called her and she said words to the effect of "*I can't pick him up this weekend. I'll come next weekend at the same time.*".
- 16. On 20 January 20XX, Jane did not arrive to collect Johnny.
- 17. In the afternoon of 20 January 20XX, I called Jane and she said words to the effect of "*I am helping a friend with something. I'll pick Johnny up next weekend*.".
- 18. On 27 January 20XX, Jane did not arrive to collect Johnny again.
- 19. On the afternoon of 27 January 20XX, I called Jane and said words to the effect of, "What is going on? When are you coming to get him? He's meant to start school in two days.". Jane replied with words to the effect of, "I can't come to get him. Can he stay with you?".
- 20. I said to Jane words to the effect of, "But he's meant to start school in two days. Do you want me to drive him to Parramatta?". Jane replied with words to the effect of, "No. He will have to stay with you. I have to go back to France tomorrow. My parents are in hospital and I don't know how long I'll be there. I will call you in the next couple of days to let you know what's happening."
- 21. On 29 January 20XX, I enrolled Johnny at Cowra High School and he attended his first day of year 7.
- 22. On Friday, 2 February 20XX, Johnny called Jane's mobile number but she did not answer.
- 23. On 12 February 20XX, I received a call from Westpac and was advised words to the effect of, "Your mortgage is five weeks and \$2,250 in arrears. This needs to be paid immediately or we will have to commence legal proceedings for the property to be sold.".

- 24. On 12 February 20XX I tried to call Jane, but her mobile phone number was disconnected. Jane did not tell me that she had stopped paying the mortgage repayments.
- 25. I immediately paid the arrears, and have met all mortgage repayments since.
- 26. On 13 February 20XX, I contacted Parramatta City Council to check whether Jane had paid the rates. I was advised words to the effect of, "You have not paid your December quarterly rates. You currently owe \$179, including interest.".
- 27. On 14 February 20XX, I received an email from our mutual friend, Sarah Friend saying, 'Jane asked me to tell you she's travelled back to France on the 1st of this month. She will give you a call later today to discuss everything.". A copy of the email from Sarah Friend dated 14 February 20XX is attached as Annexure A.
- I immediately sent Jane an email asking her to contact me urgently. A copy of my email to Jane dated
 14 February 20XX is attached as Annexure B.
- 29. I did not receive a reply from Jane to the email I sent her on 14 February 20XX.
- On 16 February 20XX, I sent Jane another email asking her to contact me urgently. A copy of my email to Jane dated 16 February 20XX is attached as Annexure C.
- 31. I did not receive a reply from Jane to the email I sent her on 16 February 20XX.
- On 17 February 20XX, I sent an email to Jane's sister, Catherine Lee, asking her to have Jane contact me. A copy of my email to Catherine Lee dated 17 February 20XX is attached as Annexure D.
- 33. I did not receive a reply from Catherine to the email I sent her on 17 February 20XX.
- 34. On 18 February 20XX, I sent an email to Jane's brother, Justin Lee, asking him to have Jane contact me.
- 35. Justin replied saying, "Jane does not want to talk to you. Please stop trying to contact her. She will get in touch with you when she is ready.". A copy of Justin's email (including my initial email) dated 18 February 20XX is attached as Annexure E.
- 36. Jane did not tell me that she was moving back to France to live permanently.
- 37. I have not seen Jane since 2 January 20XX.
- 38. I have not had any contact with her since 27 January 20XX.
