

Application for the Care and Protection Panel

This application form will need to be completed if:

- 1. Panel Law Practices (including barristers) that are not on the Care & Protection Panel (the Care Panel) and are seeking appointment; or
- 2. Eligible Associates of a Law Practice that is currently on the Care Panel but who has not yet been nominated or approved to undertake Care & Protection work;

Only the authorised Principal of a law practice or a barrister can submit this application form.

Applicants seeking to undertake legal aid work as a member of the Care Panel must satisfy the <u>individual eligibility requirements</u>.

A copy of the referee report **must** be uploaded with the application. You can upload a copy of the report when submitting your application through Panels Application web site. If you are unable to upload the report, you can email the report to <u>panels@legalaid.nsw.gov.au</u>.

Please note Legal Aid NSW will not follow up Working with Children Checks or referee reports. Application forms without this information included will not be approved.

Applications will be assessed by Legal Aid NSW and eligible applicants will be invited to attend the <u>Legal Aid NSW Care and Protection Representing Children:</u> <u>Workshop</u>.

Final approval to carry out legal aid work under the Law Practice's Care Panel membership will be confirmed once **all** the individual eligibility requirements are satisfied.
